

## Assessment & Award Regulations

1. **Course** Graduate Diploma

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	credits at level 6 with modules amounting to a total of no more than 15 credits gaining a mark between 30 and 39%. All other modules must gain a mark of 40% or more.
<b>6.</b>	<b>Consequences of Failure</b>
6.1.	A student who fails a module at the first attempt shall have a right to resit. S/he will be required to resit those pieces of work that were failed (with less than 40%) at the next available opportunity.
6.2.	Where the student has not yet completed all of the modules in a Stage, s/he will be <b>required to resit</b> any piece of work with a mark of 30-39% in order to pass a module if it has not been passed on aggregate at the first attempt.
6.3.	The module mark obtained at the second attempt will be no greater than 40%.
6.4.	When a module resit involves a piece of assessed work, the amount of time the resit student is given to do that work should be the same as on the first occasion.
6.5.	A student who fails at the second attempt will be required to relinquish the course. S/he will have a right of appeal as described in College Regulations

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
